This is a full-time, permanent position, working 75 hours bi-weekly.

The **Yukon Geological Survey (YGS)** acquires and disseminates geological and geohazard knowledge to support exploration; to inform resource and land management planning; to assist with infrastructure development; and to engage communities, schools, and the public.

Reporting to the Head of Minerals Geology, the responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to: tracking and documenting mineral industry activity in the Yukon, conducting property visits, providing information on Yukon mineral occurrences to clients and government, administering the Yukon Mineral Exploration Program, compiling and entering data into YGS' databases (e.g., Yukon MINFILE, Exploration Activity, and Exploration Footprints databases) and generating derivative products (e.g., maps, mineral assessment/mineral potential models) from geologic data sets.

Note: This is one of two YGS positions currently being advertised by the Yukon government. The other YGS position is for the Head of the Minerals Geology unit.
