**Guest Speaker: Dr. David Good, Ph.D., P.Ge.**

**Presentation: "Resource Development from a Multi-Disciplinary Perspective"**



### About the Presentation

Every year, many Western grads from every Faculty, not just geology and geophysics, are drawn into the resource sector. Over time these grads will spread out across the globe and become involved with some aspect of exploration and mining or perhaps research and teaching, but they might also join a First Nations community or a government agency or a non government organisation. How these students are prepared here at Western to meet the challenges of such a vast and complicated global industry will have a long lasting effect.

This presentation will focus on three multi-disciplinary examples related to the mining sector that illustrate the importance for developing an awareness of the interconnected nature of resource development and society. Topics addressed will include the legacy of mine tailings (failures and successes), First Nations consultation, and mining finance.

### About Dr. David Good, Ph. D., P.Ge.

David Good is the W.S. Fyfe Visiting Scientist in Earth Sciences at Western University. David received his M.Sc. from University of Toronto and Ph.D. from McMaster University where he focused on the economic geology of nickel, copper and platinum group element deposits. David was V.P. Exploration for Marathon PGM Corp. (2006-2010) and Stillwater Canada Inc. (2011-2014) where he developed a strong understanding of the inter-relationships between geology and engineering, finance, law and environmental science, and the growing significance of First Nations consultation to Resource Development. Dr. Good recently taught a graduate course that focused on best practices in sustainable mineral resource development in Ontario, and coordinated the 2017 Stephen Dattels Visiting Pre-eminent Speakers in Mining Law and Finance, with lectures open to students from Law, Earth Sciences and the Ivey Business School.
