





Why is UIA Training Needed?

- CSA Z247-15 Damage Prevention for the Protection of Underground Infrastructure
- Electricity Act O. Reg 22/04 Electrical Distribution Safety
- National Energy Board Act NEB Pipeline Damage Prevention Regulation



Public Locates



OUINS Act requires any utility owner with buried utility infrastructure crossing public right of way (ROW) must register with Ontario One Call which include:

- Utility Companies
- Municipalities
- Any Owner of a buried facility that crosses a ROW

Locates requested from Ontario One Call from these utility owners are typically called PUBLIC LOCATES

Public vs Private Locates



- Public Locates are for Utility owned buried facilities on public or private property
- Private Locates are for Private Property Owned buried facilities on private property.
- Public Utility Ownership stops at the Demarcation Point

Demarcation Points



Gas

 Usually the gas meter and sometimes beyond if they own it

Telecom (Telephone / Cable TV)

 Demarcation Box or Building Point of Entry

Water

Water Valve at the property line

Sanitary & Storm Sewer

Property Line

Hydro

- Demarcation point varies greatly...
- Hydro utility owners have allowed developers to install the hydro services to any point on their property
- Hydro utility owners will only provide a locate for what they own.
- Hydro Pole, Transformer, Buried Hydro Vault, Building Point of Entry

Private Locates



BURIED FACILITIES that exist on private property after the demarcation point.

OWNED AND MAINTAINED by the Property Owner

Required by LAW to locate before excavation – MOL

Who Marks Private Facilities?



PRIVATE LOCATE CONTRACTOR

- Works on behalf of private land owner
- Do not have a Trade Association
- Have their individual Best Practice and/or Standards
- Usually hired by the excavator working on private property

Private Locate Contractor Rules



MAKE THEIR OWN RULES FOR:

- Locate Technician Training
- Insurance Coverage
- Service Offerings
- Acceptance of Liability

Private Locate Requirements



PRIVATE LOCATOR REQUIRENTS FROM THE LAND OWNER OR EXCAVATOR:


- Access to Building Mechanical Rooms
- Property Owner Records Drawings, Survey, etc.
- Completed Public Locates
- Knowledgeable Site Operations Personnel

How to Mitigate the Hidden Dangers



- 1. Educate Your Workforce
- Qualify Your Private Locate Contractor
- 3. Plan with the Property Owner before Hiring a Private Locator
- 4. Review in Detail the Private Locate Report vs. Site Conditions
- 5. Respect the Marks on the Ground and any Limitation noted on the report.
