- Prepare/write assessments for approvals (closure plans, transfer station plans, annual monitoring reports, hydrogeological and surface water assessments), including Environmental Compliance Approval and the Environmental Activity and Sector Registry applications.
- Provide technical support in a very broad range of solid waste projects in the areas including: best practice research, solid waste planning, organics management, anaerobic digestion, resource recovery, technology assessments, waste processing recycling and sorting, landfill and transfer station operations, Solid Waste Master Plans, extended producer responsibility, curbside collection, financial modelling, and community outreach.
